The close-up before and after photos can be from any angle; the point of these images is to enable inspection of both the quality of the grafted work as well as the residual scarring in the donor area. The following are examples of before and after close-up photos of the grafted and donor areas to illustrate the type of detail we expect from these photos.

Unlike the other views required which are not close-up, it is helpful to use a comb to reveal the quality of the grafted and harvested areas.
